## Please come to the enrollment event prepared with the necessary information:

- Social Security Number OR a form of ID (driver's license, passport, or other government ID)
- Proof of eligibility:
  - Proof of income level (tax return, annual income statement, Social Security statement, or three consecutive paystubs) - OR - Proof of participation in SNAP, Medicaid, WIC, Social Security Income, Federal housing assistance, Veterans Pension, Pell grant, or free/reduced school lunch program
- Your current internet service provider OR the name of the provider you would like to use (ex. Verizon, Comcast, T-Mobile, etc.)
